Our relationships with and for one another start our hospitality with and for our guests. "Good relationships are hospitable," says Nouwen.

"When we enter into a home and feel warmly welcomed, we will soon realize that the love among those who live in that home is what makes that welcome possible." Come to think of it, our hospitality towards the stranger in our midst begins with the expression of our affection with those already near and known and loved by us.

Receiving and welcoming our guests is marked by our reception and welcome of one another. In a very real sense, it is the beginning of our ministry of being bread for the journey.

Because of your donation, CWS is able to meet emerging needs during this crisis. This week, because of you, kitchen equipment was delivered to a Ukrainian Refugee Accommodation Center in Soarta, Moldova. Up next - more kitchen equipment, bedding, and medical supplies.

Also, in Soroca, we are beginning our work with the larger community and the refugees living there. Thanks to you, we are providing cash assistance, hygiene materials, medical care, clothing and other necessities to hundreds of Ukrainian families and the Moldovan host families who are lending a hand.

This is just one place where you are making a difference. Your support has meant that CWS has built refugee service programs throughout Moldova to help those who might be there for a short time or indefinitely. Whether it is anti-trafficking programs, building a safe place for children to continue their remote schooling or equipping the local food bank - thanks to you, we can say "Welcome to safety.
